Coming to the End of the Season

Very Important Officers and Board

Once more it is time to give all you members a chance to step up and help run your club. At our next meeting we will have the "Nominations for Officers and Board Members"

To run for President you must have served on the board for 2 years, other than that there are no restrictions!

PLEASE! consider running for office.

Currently we have been running this year with one Board Member short because we couldn't get any one to commit to serving. The empty position is one that only has you work during the end of the year, Trophies & Awards. Currently Tom Ruggles has stepped up to do that position in addition to his Special Events position.

It really does not take that much time, one Board meeting at the Cracker Barrel Restaurant at Hwy 95 & The JTB, on the first Monday of the month, then attend most of the meetings. In your position you might have to make some phone calls, or order the trophies, or keep track of the fish slips and boards, but in all it is NOT a lot of work. Well Hospitality is probably the most time demanding as you have to get the food and feed about 100 people twice a month, but you can get your own committee to help you.

The board positions are assigned by the President, so you basically don't get to run for a particular position, but the president usually tries to put you where you think you will be most effective.

This club has been here for 57 years, teaching our youngsters to fish and love the outdoors. We really need to keep it running and fighting the SAMFC's attempts to close all fishing!

Here is what you need to know for fishing the Atlantic off Jacksonville!

Barracuda - 2 / day Black Drum - 14" to 24" 1 over 24" 5 / day Red Drum - 18" to 27" 2 / day Pompano - 11" Fork Length 6 / day Gag & Black - 24" TL (Total Length) - 1 / day Red, Scamp, Yellow Fin, & Yellow Mouth - 20" TL - 1/ day - Total of 3 Grouper / day Black Seabass - 13" - 7 / day Cobia - 33" FL (Fork Length) - 1 / day Dolphin (Mahi) 20" - 10 / day Kingfish - 24" FL - 2 / day Spanish Mackerel - 12" FL - 15 / day Gray Triggerfish - 12" FL - 10 / day Sheepshead - 12" 15 / day Spotted Sea Trout - 15" to 20" 1 over 20" 6 / day Weakfish - No sizelimit 100 pounds total B-Liners, (Vermilion Snapper) 12" TL - 5 / day Bluefish - 12" FL - 10 / day Flounder - 12" TL - 10 / day Greater Amberjack - 28" TL - 1 / day Tripletail - 15" TL - 2 / day African Pompano - 24" Fork L. - 2 / day Red Snapper - 20" TL - 2 / Day - FLORIDA WATERS ONLY (Within 3 Miles of shore!) Snappers - 10 / day aggregate Mangrove - 10" State, 12" Federal Lane - 8" Mutton - 16" Cubera - 12'

May possess no more than 2 Cubera Snapper over 30" per harvester or vessel per day, whichever is less. 30" or larger not included within the Snapper aggregate bag limit.

Check the Regs before each trip to make sure they haven't changed!

Don't forget that we have added TARPON to the Boards! They are a Catch & Release only fish, so catch it take a photo and measurements and send it on it's way!

What does the SAMFC require in the way of equipment?

If you are stopped by the authorities, (It does not make any difference who, they are all REQUIRED to enforce SAMFC rules.) you are required to have the following equipment on board and handy.

1 - A venting tool or a barrotruma return tool to return a bloated fish to the depths.

2 - A De-Hooking tool to remove the hook.

3 - Circle hooks, NOT Stainless Steel, and non-offset.

I strongly recommend that you go to safmc.net before every trip, as they are constantly changing their rules and inventing new reasons to close fishing. The Florida FWC can't even keep up with the changes and you are safer to have the latest regs printed out and with you to show them.


As I acquire kid friendly fishing fun, I will occasionally have a page just for the kids. Here is my first try at it.
