The Sea Bass and Grouper will start their yearly feeding frenzy this month and it will start when the water temperatures drop below 70-75 degrees.

Look for the live bait on Maxie's, Mays Wreck, The Bus Stop Barge or the twin wrecks straight out of the river at 5 miles, load the live well and go to bottom bumpin. The Grouper seem to like the big Sardines but a small grunt will work also and if you get a small legal bliner, that's candy for the larger fish in the species. That 12 inch b-liner will make the grease stink, but a 25 lb Grey Grouper will make it stink a lot more. The Sea Bass will be



I include rock piles in this category. A good place to start for any of the Sea Bass are piles of culverts and rubble, there are at least 15 good numbers in the off shore book for these areas. Do 1 drift before you anchor, the Black Sea Bass are aggressive with the largest usually biting first. Keep looking until you find the spot that hasn't been picked over and you'll get your Bass.

This season has brought us some great off shore fishing, but the inshore species are not taking much of a backseat. One of the best in recent years is the Flounder, we have watched as the fall run of flounder has gotten better each year. This year has the potential to be one of the best.



Knowing the snake couldn't bite me with the frog in its mouth, I grabbed it right behind the head, took the frog, and put it in my bait bucket.


