Mayday / Pan-Pan / Securite

Do YOU really know what they mean, and how to use them? Well now you will!

When used, repeat the words 3 times before your massage, this gets people's attention, and gives them time to pay attention to what is being transmitted.

Mayday - This means immediate danger. Only use it when you are in grave and imminent danger and require immediate help! Like man overboard and you have lost sight of them!

Pan-Pan - Urgent attention required. This is to be used for any situation that is urgent, but not imminent! Best I can think of here is like a major but not life threatening injury and you dont' have a first -aid kit that will handle it on board.


Securite - This is used to warn people of hazards like floating debris, or a hard to control barge coming in an inlet, to let boaters know to stand clear.

Here is what you need to know for fishing the Atlantic off Jacksonville in October!

Gag & Black - 24" TL (Total Length) - 1 / day

Red - 20" TL - Total of 3 Grouper / day

Black Seabass - 13" - 7 / day

Cobia - 33" FL (Fork Length) - 1 / day

Dolphin (Mahi) 20" - 10 / day

Kinqfish - 24" FL - 2 / day

Spanish Mackerel - 12" FL - 15 / day

Gray Triggerfish - 12" FL - 10 / day

B-Liners, (Vermilion Snapper) 12" TL - 5 / day

Bluefish - 12" FL - 10 / day

Flounder - 12" TL - 10 / day

Greater Amberjack - 28" TL - 1 / day

Tripletail - 18" TL - 2 / day

African Pompano - 24" FL - 2 / day

Red Snapper - 20" TL - 2 / Day - FLORIDA WATERS ONLY (Within 3 Miles of shore!)

Snappers - 10 / day aggregate

Mangrove - 10"

Lane - 8"

Mutton - 18" - 5/day

Cubera - 12' - 10 / day Plus ...

May possess no more than 2 Cubera Snapper over 30" per harvester or vessel per day, whichever is less. 30" or larger not included within the Snapper aggregate bag limit.

Check the Regs before each trip to make sure they haven't changed!

Don't forget that we have added TARPON to the Boards! They are a Catch & Release only fish, so catch it take a photo and measurements and send it on it's way!

Safety First

Safe boating should begin at home before you trailer your boat to the ramp or leave your dock or marina. To ensure that your outing on the water begins and ends safely, the first thing to do to ensure the safety of your trip on the water is to develop a float plan and leave it with your spouse, significant other, some other reliable person, or your marina. Ask the custodian of the plan to contact the Coast Guard or other local authority if you do not return by the indicated time on the plan.

The float plan should contain your name, address, phone number, name and description of your vessel, names of other persons on board, trip details including geographical location of your destination, the route you will take to get there, and/or GPS numbers if possible, time of return and time to call local authorities or Coast Guard if you do not return by the scheduled time. A properly executed float plan could be a lifesaver in an emergency if you have to abandon your vessel at sea, or break down, with no power for your radio to communicate your location and notify someone of your need for help.

A properly executed float plan would enable the person in custody of the float plan to initiate a timely search for you if you did not return by the time specified. Time could be a critical factor in saving your life in a real emergency. A simple float plan is available in the Jaxfish Website. Under "Fishing Info" - Links - Fishing Links.

File a float plan each time you go boating/ fishing to help ensure your safety on the water.

Are your flares still in date? They have an expiration date, and the Coast Guard checks!

How about your fire extinguisher? Is it good, the right type and big enough? Check them NOW, not when you need them!

How about your "First Aid" kit, is it current and ready for anything that might happen WAAAAAY offshore?

Here are some things to consider for your First Aid Kit. Remember you will probably be a Loooong way from shore when you need them!

Wire heavy duty wire cutters

(Heavy enough to cut ANY hook found

on your boat!)

Gauze pads

Gauze wrap

Butterfly band aids

Anti-biotic spray

Anti-biotic cream

"New Skin" spray (A waterproof spray

Bandaid.)

Sterile saline wash

Eye wash

Cloth Duct Tape (Gorilla tape)

Emergency blankets (The little Mylar space

blankets.)

Band-Aids

Aspirin quick dissolve

Motrin

Tylenol

Blood clotter (Known as "Wound Seal" a powder that instantly clots bad cuts.)
