The first 20' Feet of line, the entry was taken on, must accompany all Light Tackle entries. This line must break within the IGFA requirements for 8 Lb. Test Line.

Conversion chart for your Digital Scale

TENTHS of a pound to OUNCES

Example - You catch a 5.151 pound fish. You would round that UP to 5.2 pounds and that would be recorded as 5 Pounds 3 ounces.

You ROUND UP from the second decimal point only! .05 oz to .09 = +1 oz.

To knock a fish off the Board, you must beat it by $\frac{1}{4}$ of a pound, or 4 Ounces

This chart is fair and accurate and the final word for the Boards.

For an "ALL TIME RECORD" the fish must be weighed on a certified Pounds & Ounces Scale.

Tenths	=	Equivalent Ounces	-	Report your Ounces as:
.05	=	.8 oz	-	1 Ounce
.1	=	1.6 oz	-	2 Ounces
.2	=	3.2 oz	-	3 Ounces
.3	=	4.8 oz	-	5 Ounces
.4	=	6.4 oz	-	6 Ounces
.5	=	8 oz	-	8 Ounces
.6	=	9.6 oz	-	10 Ounces
.7	=	11.2 oz	-	11 Ounces
.8	=	12.8 oz	-	13 Ounces
.9	=	14.4 oz	-	14 Ounces
