Dear Jacksonville Fishing Club Members and Fellow Anglers,


I hope this letter finds you well and filled with excitement for the upcoming fishing events in our beautiful Jacksonville, Florida.

How about POSTING YOUR fish to the Boards

The Fishing Boards are totally open right now! It is the start of the new fishing year for us, and the Boards are EMPTY!

WHAT ?! You don't think you have a chance of winning one of those Big, Shiny, Gold colored TIAGRA Reels? Well . . . let me give you something to think about.



Over the last few years it has taken as little as ONE fish to win the Blue Water or Unlimited Board! The average winning number of fish posted to the boards has been **four**, that is right only (4) FOUR fish posted to a board!

Guess just WHO posted those 4 fish. Look around at the meetings, it is that person sitting next to you or at the next table! Yup, just that member that is just like you. Not some (Expert) or charter captain, just that average person like you!

It is really easy to post your fish, just go to the Club Website, www.jaxfish.com, and over to the "TOURNAMENTS" Tab, and the top dropdown menu item is the "Official Catch Entry Form".

Look at the Boards, you know you have caught fish that are bigger than what you see posted!

You may also, at the MEETING, fill out a fish Slip form and hand it to the Fishing Director.

Just fill it out and hit submit and if your fish weighs more than the fish in that slot or the slot is empty, YOU just earned yourself a "Fish Slip" and are on the Boards!



Mayday / Pan-Pan / Securite

Do YOU really know what they mean, and how to use them? Well now you will!

When used, repeat the words 3 times before your massage, this gets people's attention, and gives them time to pay attention to what is being transmitted.

Mayday - This means immediate danger. Only use it when you are in grave and imminent danger and require immediate help! Like man overboard and you have lost sight of them!

Pan-Pan - Urgent attention required. This is to be used for any situation that is urgent, but not imminent! Best I can think of here is like a major but not life threatening injury and you dont' have a first -aid kit that will handle it on board.

Securite - This is used to warn people of hazards like floating debris, or a hard to control barge coming in an inlet, to let boaters know to stand clear.

Better Boating Tips

I know that some club members tow their boats down south, so here is a great tip. Before a long tow (Specially through "Love-Bug" country) wipe your boat with liquid dish soap, (No don't wash it off yet.) and after you get where you are going, bugs and tar will come right off!

If you have a really bad tar or scum line, EasyOff oven cleaner will remove it and sticky residue from stickers, without damaging your gel coat.

Instead of using BLEACH to clean your boat, try a cup of VINEGAR in a gallon of water to make a great cleaner that is both environmentally safe, and it destroys orders better than bleach!

Quick, Easy and Tasty Fish Filets in a Pan

This recipe is for any white flesh fish. (It will even make Tilapia taste great!)

Ingredients:

- 4 1/4 Lb or bigger Filets, skin and bones removed.
 - 1/4 Cup Butter
- 1/4 Cup White Wine a Chardoney (Probably spelled wrong) is perfect for this.
 - 1/2 Teaspoon Rosemary
 - 1/2 Teaspoon Thyme
 - 1/2 Teaspoon Basil

How To:

Take the Fish out of the Refrigerator 30 minutes before cooking to allow to warm to room temperature.

Melt the butter in a large frying pan, at a medium heat. Then pour in the Wine. Add the spices, crushing them between your fingers as you add them, or grinding them finely just before adding.

Stir everything briefly, then add the filets. Cook for about 5 minutes per side, or until white and easily flaked with a fork.

Serve while still piping hot.


